हेमचंद्र यादव विश्वविद्यालय, दुर्ग द्वारा आयोजित कार्यपरिषद् की बैठक दिनांक 16.10.2019 में विषय क्रमांक 24 के निर्णयानुसार ATKT प्राप्त परीक्षार्थियों की सेमेस्टर परीक्षा प्रणाली के संबंध में पं. रविशंकर शुक्ल विश्वविद्यालय, रायपुर द्वारा लागू संशोधित विनियम क्रमांक 149 (Under the Ordinance 170) को इस विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा अंगीकृत किये जाने का अनुमोदन किया गया। यह विनियम अध्यादेश क्रमांक 170 से संचालित स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रमों में सत्र 2019-20 से प्रभावशील होगा, जो निम्नांकित है:-

Revised Regulation No. 149

(E.C. under 16-10-2019)

The regulation specifies the conduct of examination of ATKT candidates, method of internal evaluation, award of grade and credit point and other miscellaneous provisions under the Ordinance 170. (The provision of Ordinance 170 should be followed prior to application of this regulation)

1. Schedule of Semester Examination:-

- The Semester examination will be held twice in a year. The examination for I/III semester (odd semester) shall ordinarily be conducted in November/December and examination for II/IV semesters shall ordinarily be (even semester) shall ordinarily be conducted in in May/June of each year.
- A ATKT student who has to reappear in a paper prescribed for Semester I/III may do so only in the Odd Semester Examinations. A student who has to reappear in a paper prescribed for semester II/IV may do so only in the Even Semester Examinations.

2. Passing criteria and reappearance of a candidate:-

- A candidate shall be declared to have passed in each theory paper/ practical, if he/ she secure not less than 20% of marks (the internal evaluation and the external evaluation put together), provided that he/she secures a minimum of 20% of marks secured in the external examination.
- However, a candidate who has secured the minimum marks to pass in each paper but has not secured the minimum marks to pass in aggregate will reappear in any two of the theory paper/s of his choice in the concerned semester in order to secure the minimum marks prescribed to pass the semester in aggregate.
- The candidate shall appear only in the theory part and his/her previous marks in practical/project/dissertation will be carried forward and accounted for if he/she has already cleared the practical/project/dissertation.

3. Internal evaluation:-

Internal evaluation will be done in the semester in which a candidate becomes eligible to appear in the concerned semester examination.

However, the internal assessment marks obtained by the candidate in the first attempt shall be retained and considered valid for all subsequent attempts.

Out of 20 marks allocated for internal assessment for each paper:-

- 10 marks are to be assigned for class test.
- 5 marks are to be assigned for assignment/seminar presentation.
- 5 marks are to be assigned for attendance.

The marks for attendance shall be as follows:

1	More than 65% but less than 70%	1 Mark
2	70% or more but less than 75%	2 Marks
3	75% or more but less than 80%	3 Marks
4	80% or more but less than 85%	4 Marks
5	85% and above	5 Marks

4. Declaration of result during fourth semester:-

If the candidate have opted a CBCS (Choice based credit system) paper, his/her result of the fourth semester shall be withheld until he/she clears the CBCS paper.

5. Inclusion of Grade and Credit Points (CGPA) in mark sheet of the students of PG courses running under the Ordinance 170

- The grace mark, if eligible, will be awarded prior to the application of credit points and "description" modified manually.
- A student has to earn minimum number of prescribed credit in each Semester in their respective subject and a total of 80 credits for the entire course of study as specified in the syllabus.
- A student shall be awarded Master Degree who has obtained at least 4 Grade Point in a Course independently in theory and practical/lab course and minimum of 4.0 Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) will be calculated based upon SGPA of all four semesters.
- The student shall be declared successful and will be awarded CGPA/Division thought conversion of Percentage of Marks to Grade Point in 10 Point Scale in the following manner:-

Percentage of Marks	Grade Point	Description
90 and above	10	First/O
80-89	9	First/A
70-79	8	First/B
60-69	7	First/C
48-59	6	Second/D
36-47	5	Third/E
20-35	4	Third/F
Below 20	-	Dropped/Grace*/G

* If eligible; 1 (one) grace mark could be given but it will not be added the total. However, the candidate be elevated to the category of grade point 4.

v. **Calculation of SGPA:-**

$$\frac{\sum(\text{Credit of the Course} \times \text{Grade Point})}{\text{Total Credits in the Semester}}$$

vi. **Calculation of CGPA:-**

$$\frac{\text{Total Credit Point of all previous + current Semester}}{\text{Total Credits of all previous + current Semester}}$$

- A student failing to appear or securing less than 4.0 SGPA in any semester examination shall be allowed to pursue to courses for the next following Semester. Such students shall have failed or failed in aggregate (with ATKT) or ATKT status in I, II, III or IV semesters.

Note :- This revised ordinance will be limited for ordinance No. 170 and other semester Exams will be same as per there ordinances.


